



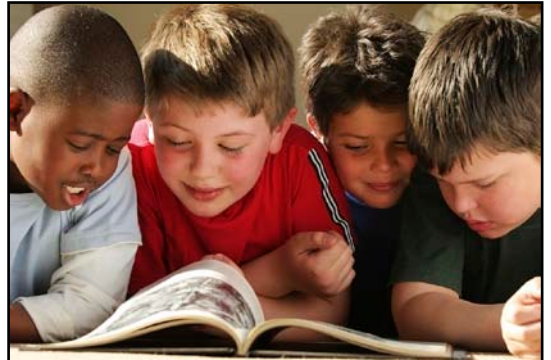

2010-2011 ADMISSIONS AND ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

ADMISSIONS PROCEDURES

- Eagle Academy welcomes students of all genders, races, nationality, or ethnic origins.
- Admission is based on the following: available space, performance on Entrance Assessment and prior school records.
- Call the **Eagle Academy Administration Office to schedule an Entrance Assessment at (904)722-9223**. All students must be assessed in order to be considered for enrollment.
- The following information must accompany the completed application packet prior to the Entrance Assessment:
 - Completed and signed **Eagle Academy Application** with recent student photo
 - Completed **Facts About Your Child** information sheet
 - Copy of the Birth Certificate
 - Copy of any progress or report cards from current or previous child care facility or school.
 - **Original blue** Certificate of Immunization [DH 680 form] (must be current)
 - **Original yellow/white** Health Exam form [DH 3020 form] (must be current)
 - **PreK-4 ONLY-A Teacher/Daycare Provider Recommendation Form** for students *must be received from the current teacher prior to the assessment.*
 - **Registration Fee** in the form of money order or cashier's check.
- Completed applications will be reviewed and Entrance Assessment scheduled in the order in which they are received.
- A parent/student interview with the Admissions Committee may be required to complete the admissions procedure. Parents will be notified in order to make an appointment.



ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

- After the Entrance Assessment and interview, parent will receive a letter of acceptance. Parent must complete an Enrollment Commitment Form and return it to the school.
- An Eagle Academy Contract and FACTS Financial Agreement must be signed to secure student's enrollment.
- The contract registers the student for one school year with the following terms:
 - Responsible parent/guardian is obligated to pay the tuition for the full academic year.
 - All school rules stated in the Parent/Student Handbook must be followed.

Eagle Academy Early Learning Center Program Options

We are pleased to offer preschool and childcare to children ages 2-4.

2 year old children must be 2 by September 1, 2010

3 year old children must be 3 by September 1, 2010

4 year old children must be 4 by September 1, 2010



PreK-2/PreK-3 Full Day Program

10 month Academic Program: Aug - May

Monday – Friday: 7:00 am – 6:00 pm

Includes morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack

PreK-2/PreK-3 Half Day Program

10 month Academic Program: Aug - May

Monday – Friday: 7:00 am – 11:45 am

All students must be picked up no later than 12:00 pm

Includes morning snack and lunch

PreK-4 Full Day Program

10 month Academic Program: Aug - May

Monday – Friday: 7:00 am – 6:00 pm

Includes morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack

Summer Component

Students who are enrolled in the 2010-2011 Academic Program are eligible to attend.

Monday – Friday: 8:30 am – 6:00 pm

Includes morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack.

Session A - June 1-30, 2011

Session B – July 1- 31, 2011

Session C– June 1 – July 31, 2011

A deposit of \$25.00 is required to secure your child's space for the Summer Component. It will be offered based on need. Summer program schedule will vary from the academic program.

Eagle Academy Early Learning Center Program Guidelines:

- The morning drop off time is 7:00 am, except for the summer program.
- All PreK programs include an instructional (i.e. academics) format, except for the summer program which will be creative and recreational.
- All full day students may be dropped off as early as 7:00 am and must be picked up no later than 6:00 pm. Anyone picking up after 6:00 pm will be assessed a late fee, which must be paid at the pickup time.
- Half day students are dismissed at 11:45 am and must be picked up no later than 12:00 noon or late fees will apply.
- Parents picking up their children between 11:45 am – 12:00 noon (half day programs) and 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm (full day programs) will use the car circle located in the front of the school. All other pick-ups must be handled through the school office.
- The tuition rate is the same regardless of attendance. School closings for holidays, planning days, etc. do not affect tuition.
- If tuition payment is missed, students will not be allowed to return to class until the payment has been satisfied.



PreK-2 Program Distinction:

- Potty training assistance will be provided for students until the age of 3.
- Parents are responsible for providing diapers and/or pull-ups for their child in training.

PreK-3 Program Distinction:

- Students should be fully potty trained.

PreK-4 Program Distinction:

- Students attending the K4 program will be academically prepared for the Somerset Academy – Eagle Campus Kindergarten program.
- Students will be required to wear an Eagle Academy uniform, which will be purchased by parents prior to the beginning of school.
- Students must be fully potty trained.
- Resource classes may be offered such as technology, Spanish, Art, Music, etc.
